## 9th Walleye Wonder

Rules \& Regulations
The following rules and regulations are designed to help make $9_{\text {th }}$ Walleye Wonder safe, attractive, and more pleasant for residents and guests. Please review these rules with your family and guests.

1. Please park all boats/trailers in the driveway. Boats/trailers parked on the street must remain attached to their tow vehicle and must adhere to all other City Ordinances. Please do not park or drive on the grass.
2. Maintenance, trash and sanitation rules.
a. Garbage and trash should be placed in the trash receptacle located in the garage. Trash day is THURSDAY. Place bin at curb Wednesday night and return to the garage once emptied. This may be trash from the previous renters.
b. No fish cleaning in the house. Use the fish cleaning table provided. It may be found in the garage and hose attached to the main house for clean-up. Do not clean fish in garage - place fish cleaning table outside. All fish waste must be placed in plastic bags and place bags in trash bin located in the garage.
c. No sanitary napkins, tampons, tissue, cigarette butts, diapers or similar material should be flushed down the toilet.
3. Please turn lights off when not in use and lock house doors and close garage door when home is unoccupied. If you have used the chest freezer that is in the laundry room during your stay, please unplug the chest freezer upon leaving, please leave the door open so it dries out.

Close all windows upon leaving the rental.
5. No pets allowed. If you have a service animal. Please let the rental company know that you have a service animal with documentation upon reservation.
6. No smoking in the house or garage.
7. Do not place hot embers from the firepit in trash bin located in the garage.
8. Accommodations are limited to the list of occupants of the house when rented. House parties are not allowed whether inside or outside the house.
9. Excessive drinking or conduct which is disorderly or disturbing to others will not be tolerated. No loud vehicle stereo music for this is a quiet neighborhood. Quiet all activities by 10:00 pm. The other homes in the neighborhood are family occupied homes.
10. No tampering with the cameras that are at the property. They are used to monitor the property when needed. They are in plain sight and are not audio.
11. Instructions for TV operation may be found on the stand below the living room TV.
12. This is a privately owned home that the owners also use. Please do not rearrange the furniture \& décor inside the home. Please return all outside furniture/ grill / table to its rightful place. It would be expected that renters would treat this home with the care of their own home during your stay.
